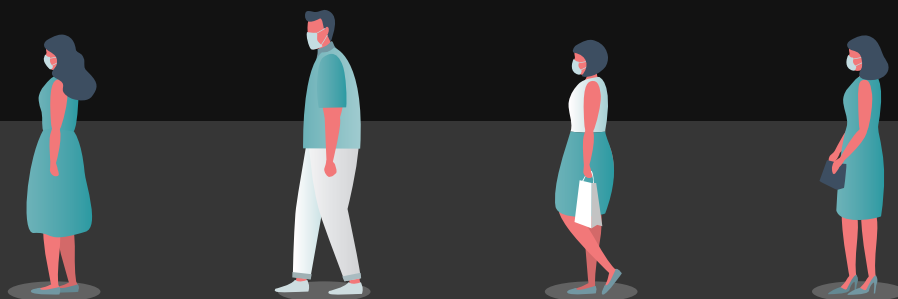
Big Changes Coming

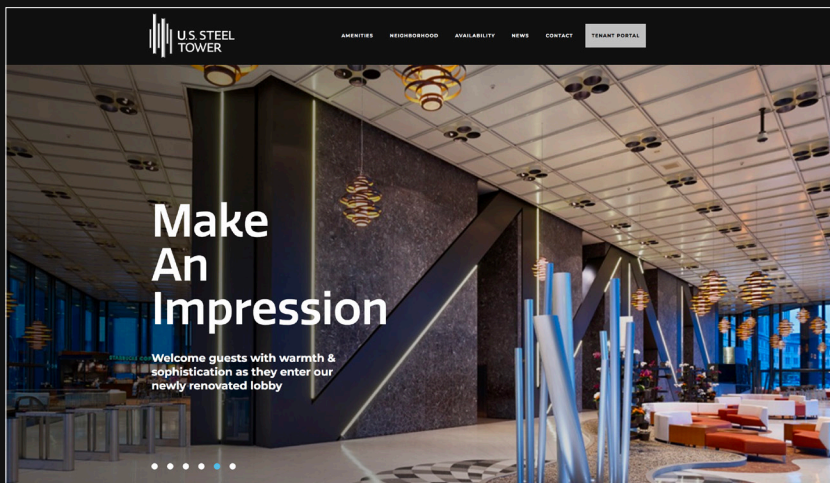
