The stunning new center features a boardroom with a 24-foot table, a training center with seating for 150 auditorium-style, an expansive reception and lounge area with nine separate seating groups, private phone/meeting rooms for two, a reception desk, pre-function space with separate serving areas and a caterer's serving pantry. Additional highlights of the center include high-speed internet throughout, video conferencing capabilities, a media wall in the boardroom and training center, 88-inch TV monitors, whiteboard areas and more.
