# **Tower Notes**

### Let's Talk Trash!

We all play a part in keeping the tower looking its best. That includes proper disposal of trash and recycling. Here's a quick refresher on our waste and recycling guidelines.

- **Daily Trash** Desk-side waste baskets are emptied each weekday during normal cleaning.
- **Boxes** Boxes should be broken down and placed in the service corridor for removal. Boxes and trash should never be left in public corridors.
- **Bulk Trash** For excess or oversized items, please request a hamper through Prism. Bulk items should not be stuffed in or around waste baskets.
- Recycling Use the blue bins for mixed office paper, plastic bottles (rinse first), cans and cardboard. Items that are not recyclable include: plastic bags, wrappers, disposable utensils, batteries, styrofoam, polystyrene clamshells/cups, coated paper containers, glass and pizza boxes.
- **E-Cycling** Electronic and computer equipment can be recycled during our e-cycling events. The next event will be January 28-29.
- **Appliances** You must submit a request through Prism for removal/ disposal of appliances, such as coffee makers, microwaves, refrigerators or anything with a plug. Please note that there is a fee for removal/disposal.

You can also support Hearts of Steel with a donation in honor of a survivor or in memory of a loved one lost to breast cancer. Scan the QR code for details and to donate.


## Halloween Happenings

## **Building Notes**

#### **Power Shutdown**

Beginning at 8 pm on Saturday, October 25th, the tower will be closed for semi-annual testing and maintenance of major systems including electrical, mechanical, elevators, fire and life safety systems. Please turn off all electrical equipment that could experience damage if power is disconnected, such as computers, coffee makers and copiers. The building is scheduled to reopen at 12 noon on Sunday, October 26th.

#### Pittsburgh Crèche
